RESOLUTION NO. 2024-20 A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE KANE COUNTY NATURAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

- The missions of Kane County and the participating jurisdiction of the Village of Lily Lake include the charge to protect the health, safety, and the general welfare of the people of eliminate long-term risk to life and property.
- The Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (Public Law 106-390) established new requirements for pre-disaster and post-disaster hazard mitigation programs.
- To remain eligible to receive mitigation monies, Kane County prepared a Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan (the "Plan") for the County and all communities in the County.
- Kane County and the the Village of Lily Lake have participated in and completed a
 planning process that engages the public, assesses the risk and vulnerability to the
 impacts of hazards, develops a mitigation strategy consistent with a set of uniform
 goals, and creates a plan for implementing, evaluating and revising this strategy.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lily Lake that:

- 1. The Village of Lily Lake adopts the Plan in its entirety and specifically Volume II of the Plan as it pertains to this jurisdiction.
- 2. The Village will
 - a. use the adopted and approved portions of the Plan to guide pre-disaster and post-disaster mitigation of the hazards identified;
 - coordinate the strategies identified in the Plan with other planning programs and mechanisms under its jurisdictional authority;
 - c. continue its support of the Hazard Mitigation Steering Committee and continue to participate in the planning partnership as described by the Plan; and
 - d. help to promote and support the mitigation successes of all planning partners.
